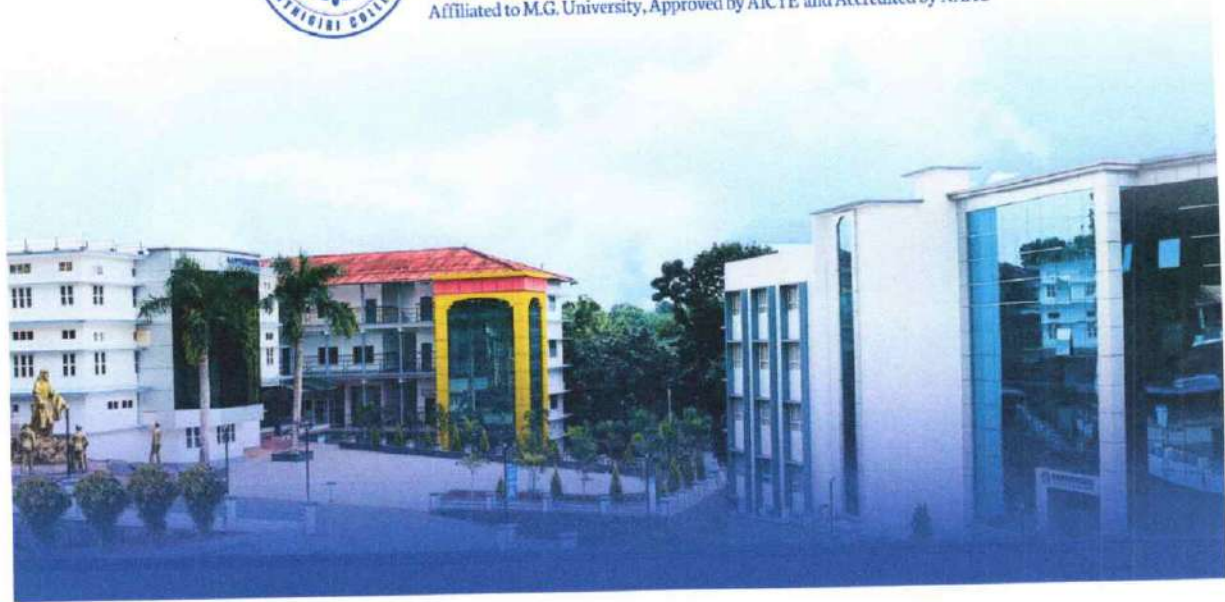

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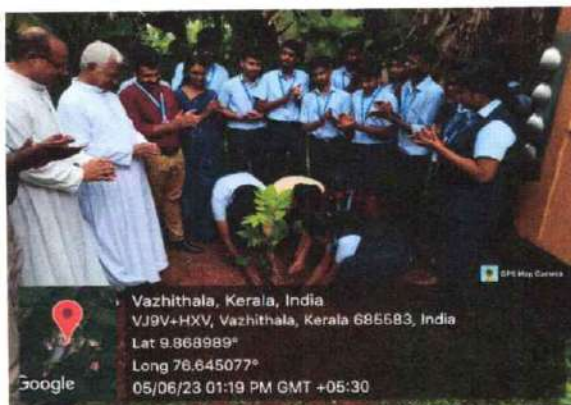
"EXPLORING KNOWLEDGE AND NATURE: STAFF TRIP TO BHOOTATHANKETTU"

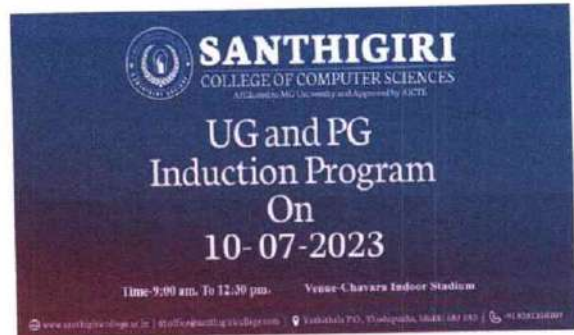

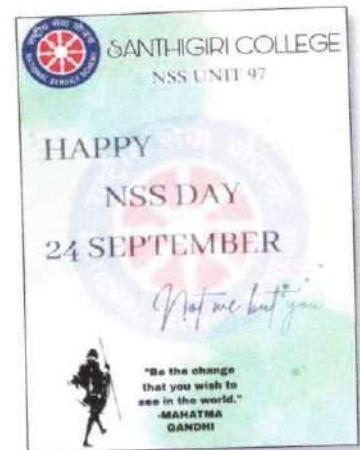




Press's commitment to delivering excellence. This surely will elevate the standards of print media production, making it a valuable asset for the press and the community it serves.

CAMPUS CLEANING - NSS DAY CELEBRATION

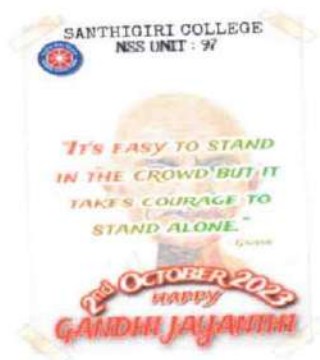

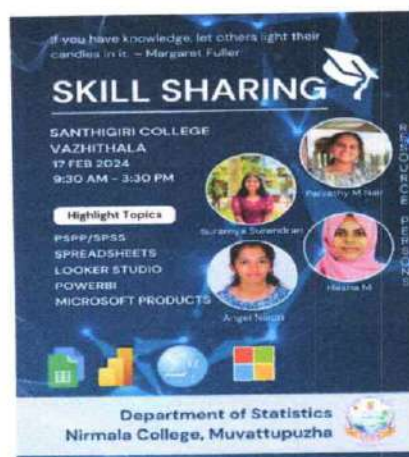
SKILL SHARING PROGRAMME

cheers and applause as teams spiked and blocked their way to victory. Meanwhile, the badminton courts witnessed thrilling rallies and smashes,



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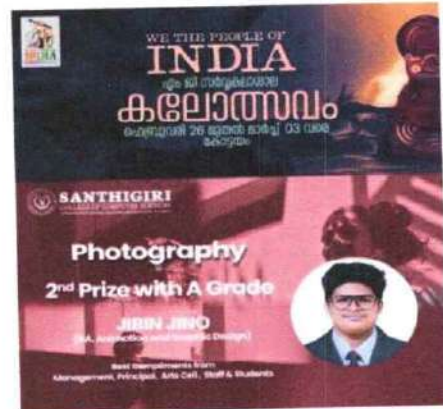

WE THE PEOPLE OF INDIA 2023-24

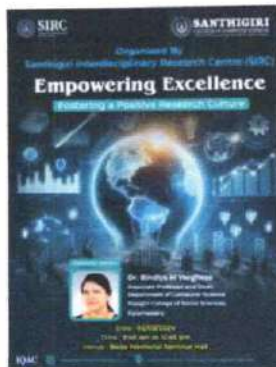

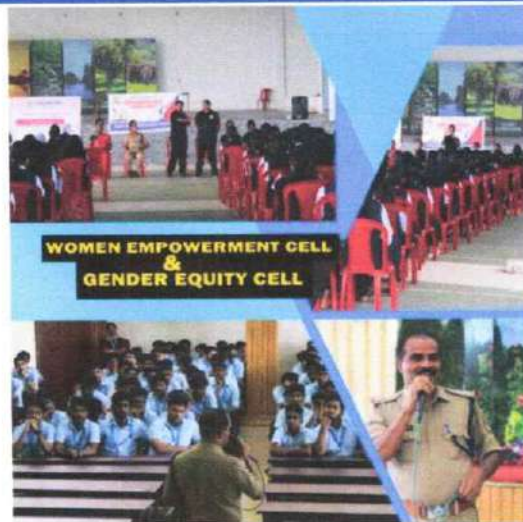


basis for a peaceful, prosperous and supportable world. On the day, speaker took a session to discovering the powerful self in ourselves,

The **Attendance Engagement Overview Report** provides a detailed view of department-wise staff attendance and engagement on an hourly basis. Using filters, administrators can focus on specific departments and assess teacher availability and substitutions. Color codes indicate attendance status: Light Green for class attendance without a timetable, Dark Green for timetable-based attendance, Red for absence, Grey for absence with a substitute, and Yellow/Orange for substitute teachers. This tool ensures smooth operations and allows for quick identification of attendance patterns.



The **Event Attendance Management System** helps event coordinators efficiently add, edit, and delete events. Coordinators can track attendance for each event, ensuring accurate records of participants. This system serves as a comprehensive tool for event organization, making it easier to manage details and track attendance over time.

The **Timetable Management System** aids administrators in creating and managing academic timetables. It allows for customized day orders, time slots, and easy allocation of teachers to courses. Features like Auto Template and Copy Slots streamline scheduling, while attendance tracking automatically adjusts timetable entries. This system ensures efficient scheduling and simplifies record-keeping.



The **Student Services Menu** enables administrators to monitor and manage student academic and behavioral progress. It provides insights into students' academic standing and disciplinary actions, allowing administrators



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to track and update records. This system helps maintain accurate student data and fosters a supportive environment for their academic development.

NPTEL COURSE

Participants can learn and explore new technologies and acquire a certificate from IIT after the successful completion of the course. One of the basic objectives of NPTEL is to bring all the best



teachers in the country under the umbrella of NPTEL and to collaborate with IITs and IISc to record the lecture and make their courses available to the communities of the country under the agreement of the free and open source. In our campus we are providing NPTEL as add on course as the students will get certificates from the best institutes in India. Students should

opt for 8 weeks or 12-week NPTEL online course, not promote 4-week courses. Student should submit assignments every week and its 25 marks for assignment and 75 in final examination. Students need to get a 40 percentage of marks in each category to get certification. Tutors or Mentors of each course will monitor the progress of students and the mark obtained in NPTEL.

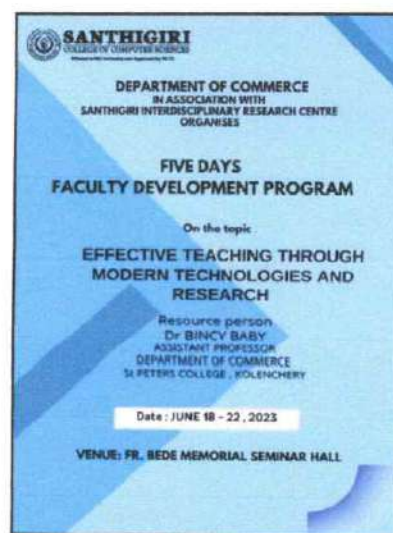


multidisciplinary education and improving the research conditions which encourage the faculty member to think creatively.

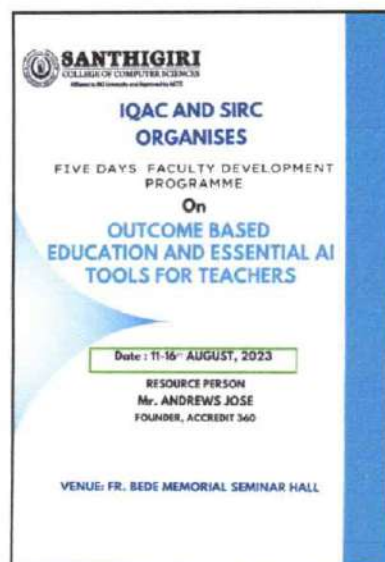

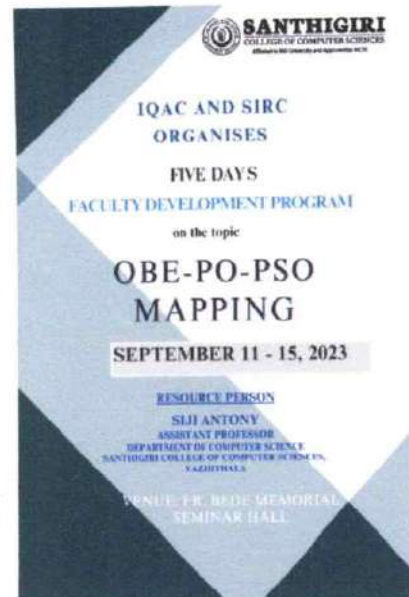
OBE-PO-PSO MAPPING
