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# Grievance Redressal Cell

Grievance Redressal Cell of Santhigiri is to provide a mechanism for redressal of students Grievance and to prevent unfair practices. The function of the Cell is to look into the complaints lodged by any student, and judge its merit. The Grievance Cell is also empowered to look into matters of harassment. The Grievance Redressal is constituted with Principal as its Chairman and other members assigned by the Principal as its executive members..

### Policy:

Procedure for lodging complaint

The students may feel to put up a grievance in written or verbal format to the concerned class tutor.

In case the person is unwilling to appear in self, grievance may be dropped in writing at the letter box of the Grievance Cell near Principal cabin.

If any complaint /Grievance is lodged by any of the student, the protocol that followed is to receive a written complaint by the complainant to the class tutor. Class tutor will review the case and based on the merit it is forwarded to the Head of the Department. Head of Department will forward the matter to the Grievance Redressal committee.

Grievance Redressal will attend the cases by giving opportunity to both parties to be heard. In case of inter departmental issues, heads of department along with the class tutor is summoned to the Grievance Cell. Complainant and the defendants version is heard and received in written format. On receipt of this Committee will verify the merit of case by summoning witnesses, CCTV footages and teachers testimony.

Decision will be taken by the Grievance Cell within 5 working Days and will send for Chairman's Approval. Chairman will intimate the final decision to the class tutor of the respective student. And the class tutor will communicate the decision to the parties of the case and to the parent.
